Classes for Adult English Learners were designed to teach students literacy and life skills in an engaging, compassionate setting. Spring Forward managed the onsite program for students' pre-K children.

Spring Forward has always worked to combat the "summer slide" by offering enrichment camps annually to more than 400 students in the Rock Island-Milan School District. This year we were unable to meet in-person for camp due to the COVID-19 pandemic, but offered a remote camp. The camp was highlighted by weekly Summer Success Kits, which were distributed to families. The Kits included 2-3 new, grade level books, activities provided by Spring Forward teachers and community partners.









